



REGULATIONS AND SCHEDULE FOR THE TV FINALS

2024 BOWLING PRO-MOTION TOUR / MONDAY, OCTOBER 7, AND TUESDAY, OCTOBER 8

After the 18 qualifying games (Bayeux 6 games, Rennes 6 games, Fontaine le Comte 6 games), here are the regulations for the organization of the TV finals of the 2024 Bowling Pro-Motion Tour (Sphere Bowling Fontaine le Comte).

TV FINAL LANES = Lanes 5 - 6 for both days

DAY 1

BPT WOMEN'S DOUBLES (2 MATCHES)

Here are the doubles pairings for the top 6 women from the qualifiers.

Double #1 (Players ranked #1 and #2 in total qualifiers)

Double #2 (Players ranked #3 and #4 in total qualifiers)

Double #3 (Players ranked #5 and #6 in total qualifiers)

Warm-up on lanes 19-20 (10 minutes before the referee calls for the TV finals).

Semi-Final : Double #2 VS Double #3

The captains decide the playing order, and the captain of Double #2 selects the lane.

Final : Double #1 VS Winner of the Semi-Final

The captains decide the playing order, and the captain of Double #1 selects the lane.

The captains decide the playing order, and the captain of Double #2 selects the lane.

Final : Double #1 VS Winner of the Semi-Final
The captains decide the playing order, and the captain of Double #1 selects the lane.

 The player who occupies 8th place at the end of qualifying must defend his position in the bracket.
 This player finds himself directly in ROUND 4.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

In case of a tie, different tie-breaking methods are applied depending on the round.

For tiebreakers: Matches tied in eliminations will be decided by the last game played, favoring the highest score. If tied again, the previous game will be considered, and so on. For "Baker System" or individual matches, ties are broken by a one-ball throw with 10 pins, favoring the highest score. If tied again, another throw follows the same rule.

For individual matches and Mixed Doubles, women have 8 bonus pins per game during the 18 games of qualifying as well as TV Final matches. However, the maximum score taken into account for a woman, including bonus, cannot exceed 300.

A 30-second timer, visible to the players, is under the authority of the referee during each televised match. The timer is triggered when the player performs a game action.

Individually, the first overtime will be punished with a warning (White Card), the second overtime (Yellow Card), the throw will be counted as 0 (Zero). It will be the same for the following ones.

By team, the first time overrun will be punished with a warning (White Card), the second time overrun by the team, the throw will be counted as 0 (Zero). It will be the same for the following throws.

In the event of a team or player withdrawing for whatever reason, the absent team or player will be declared the loser without any further notice. impact.

In all circumstances, players must wear correct clothing and behave in a sporting manner.
During the entire competition, smoking and consuming alcoholic beverages are prohibited.

Cleaning your ball with solvent products (USBC approved) or using abrasives is only permitted between phases of the competition. Participation in the Bowling Pro-Motion Tour 2024 entails full acceptance of these regulations.
